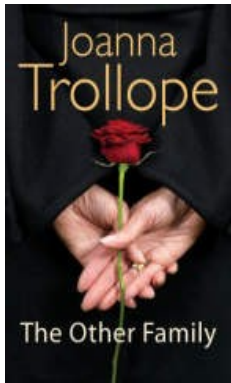


Trollope, Joanna. The Other Family

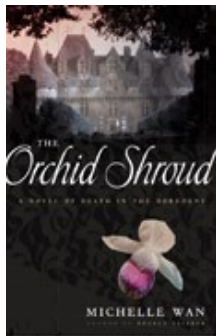


Richie dies suddenly leaving Chrissie, the partner he never married, and their three daughters to endure grave consequences when it is realized that Richie's other family are in his will.

A Literary mystery about a woman's search for her long-missing sister takes readers to the ruggedly beautiful Dordogne region of France and into the exotic world of orchid hunting.

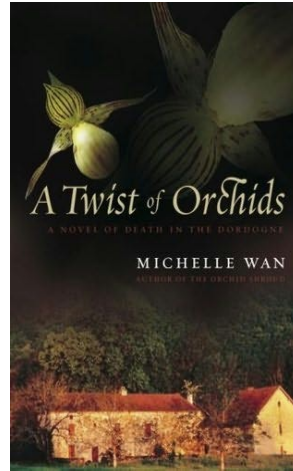

Allende, Isabel. Island Beneath the Sea



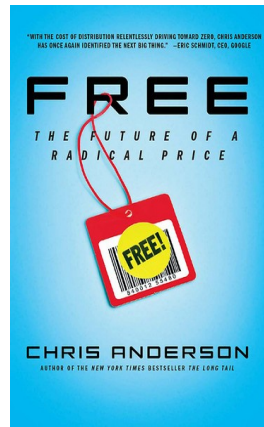
Allende crafts the riveting story of one woman's determination to find love in New Orleans amid a life of loss after years of bondage on the island of Saint-Domingue.



Chiaverini, Jennifer. The Aloha Quilt

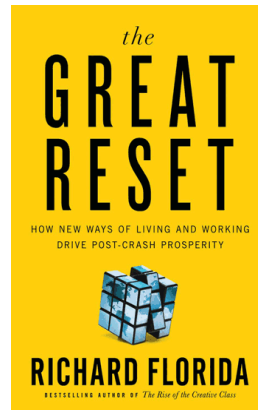
Another one of Jennifer's great mysteries this time set in the exotic island of Hawaii.

Anderson, Chris. Free: the Future of a Radical Price



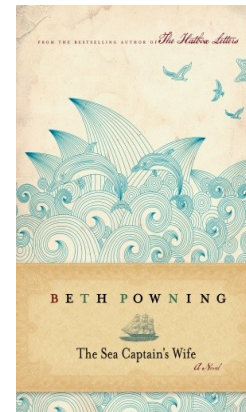

Florida, Richard. The Great Reset



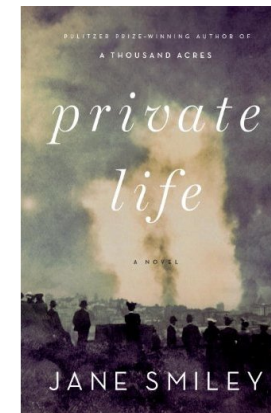
